10'x10' space for a full year (13-15 markets) - \$100.00

10'x 10' space for half a year (7 markets) - \$60.00

10'x 10' space per week (1 market) - \$10.00

The Market runs from 2-6pm every Friday from the first Friday in July to the final Friday in September. Vendors may arrive as early as 12:30 pm the day of the market to set up, and MUST be ready to sell by the time the market opens at 2pm. Spaces are 10'x10' and are available on a full season OR weekly basis. The following form must be completed regardless of whether the vendor is participating in the full season or on a weekly basis.

All vendors must provide a Certificate of Insurance with a liability limit of no less than \$1 million and shall name the Cuba Farmers' and Artisans' Market and the Cuba Cultural Center, Inc. as additionally insureds.

Each vendor is responsible for their own property and the Cuba Farmers' and Artisans' Market and the Cuba Cultural Center, Inc. Are not responsible for any damage, theft, or loss for any reason.

The Cuba Farmers' and Artisans' Market is unable to provide electrical and/or water hook up for vendors. All vendors must bring the necessary equipment with them to furnish their own unique needs.

The Cuba Farmers' and Artisans' Market caters to the needs of all its customers including, but not limited to, facilitating SNAP purchases on qualifying items, participating in New York State's Farmers Market Nutrition Program (enabling WIC and Senior benefits to be accepted), Just Say Yes through Foodlink, and Double Up Food Bucks. The Market Manager can process SNAP sales if you as an individual vendor are unable. Not accepting SNAP benefits WILL NOT disqualify you from this Market. Majority of the questions above request information to allow us to partake in the grants/ programs.
